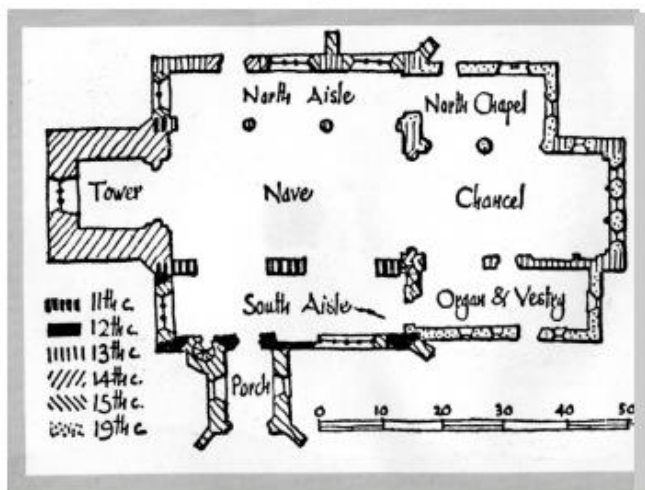
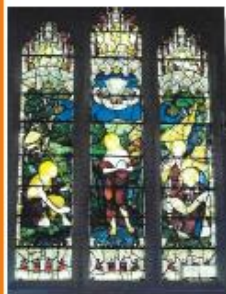
St Mary's Electoral Roll

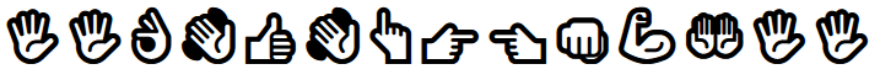
